

Computed Tomography (CT) Program Application and Competitive Requirements

 If you are a new student to LTC complete an Application for admission https://www.laniertech.edu/admissions/ indicate "Computed Tomography" on the application form as your intended program of study.
 Applicants transferring from other colleges must have official transcript sent directly to the LTC office of admissions. It is the student's responsibility to confirm transferability of equivalent coursework with the LTC Registrar before application deadline.
 Applicants to the CT program must be a registered technologist in radiography, radiation therapy or nuclear medicine in good and regular standing. The applicant's registry card must be submitted.
 Valid TEAS VI Test results no less than 5 years old. Must submit hard copy of TEAS Test or ensure test result is showing on ATI website. <u>All forms submitted must be in pdf format.</u>
 Acceptance into CT program will be based on Highest TEAS Test scores. In the event several applicants produce equivalent test scores, their radiography/modality program GPA will be calculated for a tie breaker. There is no wait list, applicants have to reapply every year.
 Students currently enrolled in the Lanier Technical College Radiography Program may be granted provisional acceptance contingent on upon providing a passing ARRT Registry Test Score (if space allows).
