Lanier Technical College uses a selective admissions process for the **Dental Hygiene Program**.

One of the criteria used to determine program acceptance is the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Allied Health Entrance Test. There is a fee required to take the test, and the test is required for all applicants.

The Dental Hygiene Program adheres to the following guidelines:

- The TEAS test may be taken no more than two times in a calendar year.
- At least 30 days must be allowed between each testing attempt or the second attempt will not be accepted.
- TEAS scores greater than two years old will not be accepted.
- Online testing is not approved. Proof of the testing facility location will be required.

You must present a photo ID at the testing session in order to be allowed to test. No Transfers or Refunds are allowed.
