

Radiologic Technology Program ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam Information

Dear Student (Applicant):

Lanier Technical College uses a competitive admission process to enroll students in the **Radiologic Technology Associate of Applied Science Program**.

NOTE: The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Allied Health Entrance Test is required for all applicants. This test will be referred to as the **ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam**. The **ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam** must be taken in person. We do not accept results from online testing.

There is a fee required to take the ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam. Students will not be allowed to take the ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam more than two (2) times per application year (June 1 through May 31), and there must be a minimum of thirty (30) days between attempts. Scores are valid between June 1 and May 31 preceding the Fall application year only. (Ex. Scores are valid if ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam is taken between June 1, 2025 to May 31, 2026 for a Fall 2026 cohort start) Students must pay a fee for each ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam attempt.

You must present a photo ID at the testing session in order to be allowed to test. No Transfers or Refunds allowed. ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam scores taken at other institutions must be sent by the testing service (ATI) to "Lanier Technical College Gainesville AH"

If the testing site at Lanier Technical College is full, you may take the **ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam** at another college. Note: The testing agency (ATI) does not automatically send us a score if you take the ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam at another college. Applicants must pay a fee to ATI to have the score sent to "Lanier Technical College Gainesville AH" Instructions can be found at the following link: https://www.atitesting.com/ati_store/product.aspx?zpid=942

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the radiologic technology program has been sent a current **ATI TEAS Version 7 Exam** score from outside colleges and it is the applicant's responsibility to make sure their radiologic technology application is up to date and complete by May 31.
